Islamabad (June 29 2005): Prof. Khurshid Ahmad has expressed great concern on the flood situation in NWFP. The Provincial Government is doing its best but is miserably handicapped by the lack of resources. The Prime Minister's Rs.10 Crore Relief Package is absolutely inadequate to properly provide relief to the flood affected areas.. It is a state of national emergency and requires the Federal Government to release enough resources to enable the Provincial Government to meet the big challenge.

Prof. Khurshid Ahmad also appealed to all relief agencies within the country to extend fullest support to those affected by floods. It is only through Government-Public participation that such a challenge can be met.
